To make your Family Worship experience more enjoyable, talk to your children before family worship about your expectations, what they are able to do, and ask them to help prepare their worship bag with quiet activities. Sit toward the front where it is easier to see and hear. If you have to leave the service with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back.

Worship Bag

Make a worship bag for your child. Let them make the bag their own. Write your name on it, fill it with quiet activities & bring it back when you come to worship.

Some ideas for your bag include:

- ◆ coloring books
- ◆ Crayons
- ◆ activity books
- ◆ Journals/notepads
- ◆ Christ centered book
- ◆ quiet fidget toys, etc.
