WHY?

Teaching children Godly ways to manage their resources is also about understanding who we are dependent upon and who is the source of all our blessings. Without guidance children are likely to adopt worldly money principles rather than Godly teachings.

WHAT?

This workshop is designed to help families talk about stewardship and put in place some of the elements of Dave Ramsey's Financial Peace class as they teach their children Godly ways of managing their resources.

How?

TIPS FOR GETTING STARTED:

Model it: Start by putting into practice some of the steps you want your child to learn. If you haven't already you may want to check out Dave Ramsey's Class, Financial Peace University.

Teach it: Help you child divide up their allowance or spending money into envelopes, jars or a bank divided into give, save, spend categories.*

- Help your child distinguish between needs versus wants.
- Use allowance or a commission
- Let them make mistakes
- Teach them patient...let them save up to purchase something.
- Help them to make goals.
- Teach them to share.
